In 2012, the Lao PDR had an honour to host the 9<sup>th</sup> ASEM Summit in Vientiane and in October 2017 organised the 6<sup>th</sup> ASEM Seminar on Water Resources Management and Sustainable Development in Champasak Province, which reflects yet another commitment of the Lao PDR to the enhancement of Asia-Europe cooperation.

On this auspicious occasion, I would like to express my sincere appreciation to all ASEM Members for their continuous supports, cooperation and assistance extended to the Lao PDR. I sincerely hope that the long-lasting and good cooperation between Asia and Europe will be further strengthened and moved forwards into a new level for mutual benefits of the people of the two continents.
